Front Range-Midway Solar Project

The Front Range-Midway Solar Project is a subsidiary of Tradewind Energy. The company is planning a 100-megawatt solar array within the Hanover School District. The exact location is west/southwest of Pikes Peak International Raceway, just north of the Waste Management waste dump, and less than 2-miles to the north of Prairie Heights Elementary School.

The project covers approximately 900-acres of land. The project is located adjacent to the existing Western Area Power Administration substations. Shovels will hit the ground by first guarter of 2019, and be complete in 2019.

The project will provide some improvement to the current condition of a key road for use in transporting students, 2-3 full time jobs, 200 construction jobs, and a potential offset of 182,000 metric tons

Tradewind Energy has committed to support the school district. One consideration is to build a small solar array at each school site to offset some of the district's utility costs.

In 2016 Colorado ranked 11th in the US for solar installs, and is expected to install over 1.681 megawatts over the next five years.

The solar project will provide an estimated \$320,800 in property taxes of which \$25,500 would be for fire, \$103,500 for metro, and \$22,000 for library.
